- **Welcome and Introductions – Matt Crookshank**
 - Matt Crookshank opened the meeting at 9:05 a.m. via conference call. Roll call was taken.
 - Information was shared that homeless were pitching tents at Huff Lane ball park and gathering on Hershberger Road near Krispy Kreme Doughnuts.

- **Homeless Data Integration Project – Andria Ukrop, DHCD**
 - Andria Ukrop made a Power Point presentation on the Homeless Data Integration Project that will warehouse data for state policy makers, DHCD, CoC's and other stakeholders.
 - HMIS data from CoC's across the state can be uploaded to Green River's Open Path software (cloud based) to provide comprehensive data to end homeless within Virginia.
 - The integrated system will provide:
 - a. maximized use of data and creation of CoC reports for outcome measures.
 - b. standardized data-sharing policies, procedures, and practices among all Virginia CoC's.
 - c. support statewide efforts to make data-driven funding decisions.
 - d. develop training and have it available to CoC's.
 - There will be three phases:
 - a. Pilot Project
 - b. Integration of remaining CoC's not in Pilot Project
 - c. Care Coordination
 - A statewide system will ensure everyone in need has access to services in Virginia.
 - Aggregate data will be readily available to legislators to show progress with policies.
 - Andria also reviewed several sample screens and reports that will be available on the dashboard.
